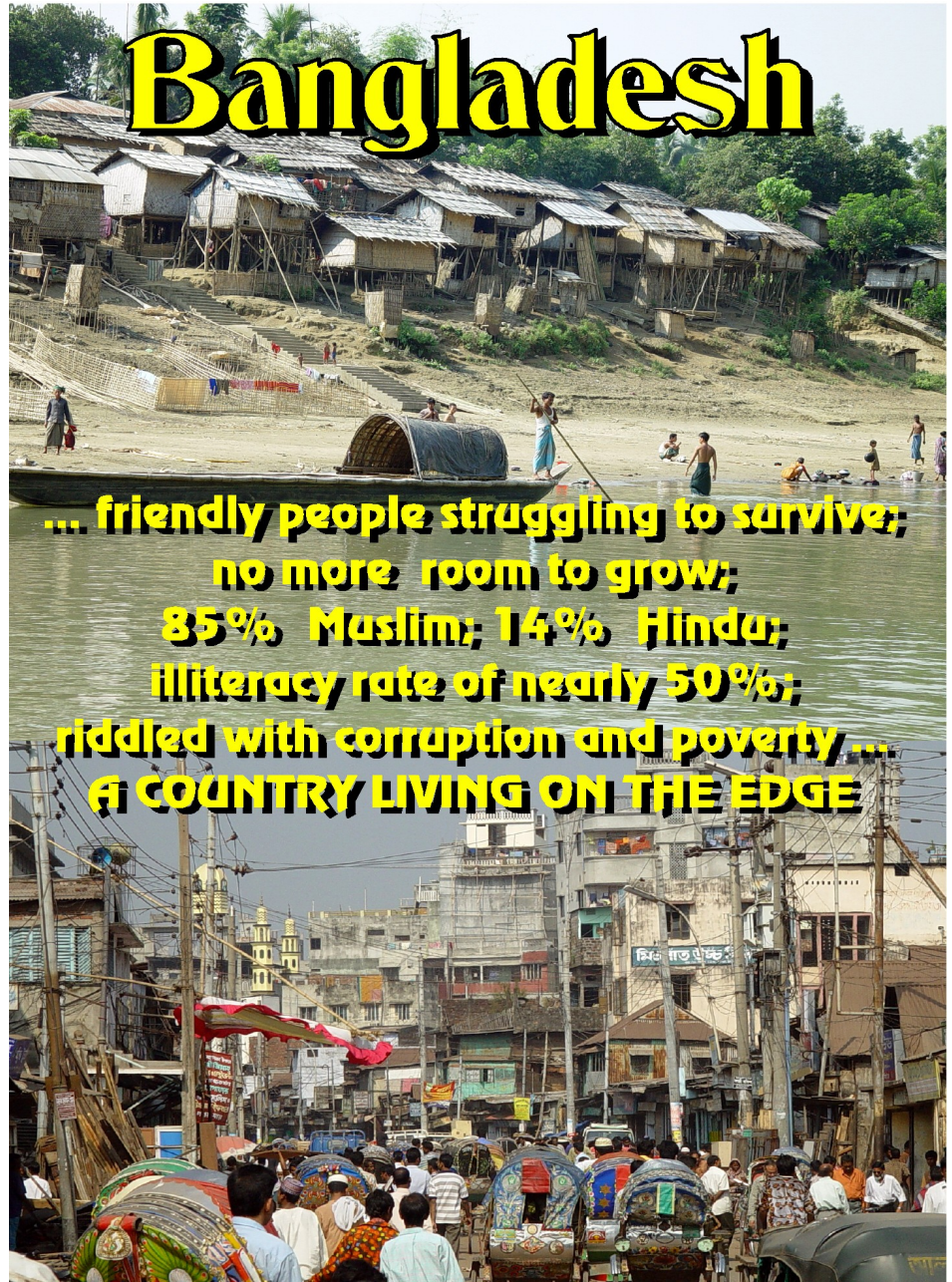
The Tribals of Bangladesh 6:21 They can be found deep in the jungles, along steep, mountain slopes and at the river's edge. They are all but lost and forgotten.
